



Thought of the day:

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It's Craft Time!

In today's story, Daniel trusted God and stayed safe in the lion's den! Just like Daniel, we can trust God to protect us. Now, let's make lion masks to remember how God kept Daniel safe. Get ready to roar, and remember, God is always with us



Preparation:

- Draw a lion's face on the paper plate as shown in the given image.
- Carefully cut out the lion's face—ask an adult for help with the scissors!
- Cut out ears and its hole from another paper plate and attach them to the sides of the lion's face.
- Color the lion's face using crayons to make it bright and fun!
- Cut strips of orange and yellow paper for the lion's mane.
- Glue the paper strips around the back of the plate to create the mane.
- Attach a lollipop stick at the bottom as a handle for the mask.
- (Optional) Instead of a handle, punch two holes on the sides and thread a string to wear the mask.
- Now your lion mask is ready to ROAR! Have fun, and remember to be careful with the scissor

Materials Needed:


- White paper plate




How about looking at the pictures of Moses and the Israelites escaping from Egypt?



Pharaoh sent soldiers to bring the Israelites back. The Israelites were very sad and scared.


When we are scared or don't know what to do, we can trust God. He will help us, just like He helped Moses and the Israelites!

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Let's color beautifully how Moses helped the Israelites cross the Red Sea.





Ask children questions about the lesson. When they answer correctly, they can color a square and move through the Red Sea until they reach the other side.




LESSON 3

Jesus took the girl's hand and said


Right away, she stood up and walked! Everyone was so happy! Jesus told them to give her food


Greetings in the name of Holy Triune God Almighty,

- 3. Jesus is Our Source of Joy**


Through these lessons, children will discover how to trust in God, see His presence in every phase of life, and experience the unwavering joy that comes from knowing Jesus Christ.
