





Lesson 1

TRUST IN GOD EVEN IN HARD TIMES



Dear Father, we come before You with grateful hearts, acknowledging Your unwavering faithfulness in our lives. As we embark on today's class, we ask for Your strength to trust You wholeheartedly, regardless of the circumstances we face. Amen.

Objective: To help children Understand the importance of trusting God during struggles and to have faith in God.



Thought for the day: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight." (Proverbs 3:5-6)

Introduction:

Life often presents us with challenges that test our faith and resilience. During such times, trusting in God becomes essential. The Bible offers numerous examples of individuals who faced adversity yet remained steadfast in their faith, providing valuable lessons for us today.

Ask yourself????



- ⬇ Have you ever gone through a tough time where you felt scared or alone?
- ⬇ How did you react? Did you trust God or feel like giving up?
- ⬇ Were you able to REJOICE in God when your life was difficult?

Let's learn

Why Should We Trust God? Trusting God is not always easy, especially in difficult times, but the Bible gives us strong reasons to rely on Him.

Let us find the reasons why we should trust God

1. **God is in Control** (Psalms 37:5-6) - We may feel life as uncertain, but nothing surprises God. He knows the past, present, and future. Even when we don't understand, God's plan is perfect.
2. **God's Promises Never Fail** (1 Kings 8:56)-Humans may fail us, but God always keeps His promises. When God says He will provide, protect, and guide us, He truly will.
3. **God Works Everything for Our Good** (Romans 8:28) - Even when we face hardship, God is working behind the scenes for our benefit.






4. **God is Always with Us** (Isaiah 43:2) We are never alone, God's presence is constant even in the darkest times.
5. **God Knows What is Best for Us** (Jeremiah 29:11) Sometimes, we think we know what's best, but God sees the bigger picture.

HOW JOB MODELED "TRUSTING GOD IN DIFFICULT TIME"

In today's world, many people face challenges—family struggles, financial problems, sickness, loss, bullying, and peer pressure. The story of Job teaches us that even in our hardest moments, we must trust God, because He has a greater plan for us.



- * Who Was Job? (Job 1:1-5)
 - ✦ Job was a wealthy and righteous man who loved God and did everything right. He had a good family, a successful life, and many blessings. But one day, everything changed.
- * What Happened? (Job 1:6-2:13)
 - ✦ Job lost all his wealth.
 - ✦ His children died in a tragic accident.
 - ✦ He got painful sores all over his body.





**Theme: I will rejoice in the Lord
Habakkuk 3:18**

- ✦ His friends blamed him, saying he must have done something wrong.
- ✦ Even his wife told him to give up on God!

Despite all this, Job remained faithful. He didn't understand why he was suffering, but he trusted God.

Many of us go through difficult times and wonder, "Why is this happening to me?"

Let's connect Job's struggles to challenges in today's society:

- ◆ Loss and Hardships (Family and Financial Struggles)
 - ✦ Parents losing jobs or struggling financially.
 - ✦ Divorce and family conflicts, causing pain and confusion.
 - ✦ Loss of a loved one, making it hard to stay hopeful.



Remember! Job lost everything but even in loss, God was in control. Likewise he sees our pain and will restore what is lost in His perfect time.

- ◆ Peer Pressure and Bullying
 - ✦ Bullying at school or social media.
 - ✦ Judgment from peers for being different.
 - ✦ Feeling left out or misunderstood.



Remember! Job's friends judged him, Just like Job, don't let negative voices shake your faith. Trust in God's love and purpose for you.

- ◆ Sickness and Mental Health Struggles
 - ✦ Illness or health problems.
 - ✦ Anxiety, depression, or stress.
 - ✦ Feeling like God is far away.



Remember! Job suffered physically, emotionally, and mentally. Similarly even when our life feels unbearable, God has not abandoned us. He hears our prayers and will bring healing in His time.

And in the end: (Job 42:10-15)

- ✦ God restored his health.
- ✦ God blessed him with wealth.
- ✦ God strengthened his faith to understand that God's plan is bigger than our struggles.

Introduction:

Life is filled with challenges, uncertainties, and moments of hardship. Jesus assures us that no trial is too great, no storm is too strong, and no darkness is too deep for His light to overcome. In Him, we find strength, peace, and courage to press on, knowing that ultimate victory belongs to Christ.

Let's learn

Let's be real—life isn't always easy, it Comes with Challenges# We all go through struggles, whether it's stress from school, friendship, family problems, social media influence, or just feeling overwhelmed. Sometimes, we feel that no one understands what we're going through.

- When we feel weak, God's power is made perfect in us.
- No matter how big our struggles are, God is bigger!
- When we feel tired and worn out, God gives us new strength.
- Like an eagle soaring in the sky, God helps us rise above our problems.
- God commands us to be strong and courageous.
- We don't have to fear because God is always with us.

Why do we need God's Strength?

Promises on God's Strength



* **God Sees the Struggles:** In 1 Peter 5:7, the Apostle reminds us to **Cast all our anxiety on God because He cares for us.** God knows exactly what we're facing, and He cares deeply about us. He never promised that life would be easy, but He did promise that He would be with us every step of the way.



* **God is always on our side:** In Romans 8:31, St Paul affirms that **"If God is for us, who can be against us?"** No matter how weak or discouraged we feel, God is on our side. When we lean on Him, He will give us the courage to keep going.

* **God has better Plans:** In Isaiah 55:8 God says **"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways."** It's not always easy to understand why we go through certain struggles. But even in the hardest moments, God is working things out for our good. Instead of letting difficulties bring us down, trust that He has a purpose for what we're facing.

* **God is Mightier:** Philippians 4:13: **"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."** This verse is a powerful reminder that no matter what challenges we face, we don't have to rely on our own strength—God gives us the strength we need to overcome anything. Keep praying, keep trusting, and keep moving forward—because with God on our side, we can overcome anything.



Let's find out

HOW GOD GAVE STRENGTH TO SHADRACH, MESHACH, AND ABEDNEGO

Children today face many challenges—peer pressure, bullying, negative influences, and the temptation to compromise their faith to fit in. The story of 3 children like you (Read Daniel 3) teaches us that God gives us strength to overcome difficulties when we stand firm in our faith.

Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were three young men living in Babylon under King Nebuchadnezzar. The king built a huge golden statue and ordered everyone to bow down and worship it. But these three men refused because they knew that worshiping anything other than God was wrong. Their decision made the king furious, and he threatened to throw them into a fiery furnace. Even though they knew the consequences, they boldly told the king. The king followed through on his threat, throwing them into the furnace. But instead of burning up, they were protected by God, and a fourth figure (believed to be an angel or even Jesus Himself) appeared with them. When they were brought out, they didn't even smell like smoke! **Their faith in God led to their victory.**

"We will not bow down. The God we serve is able to save us. But even if He does not, we will still not worship your statue."

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Lessons for us

Your Problem	God's Reassurance
Many children feel pressured to follow the crowd—whether in choosing friends, engaging in bad habits, or abandoning their faith.	Like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, stand firm and trust that God will give us strength to resist negative influences.
Today, peer pressure can make us feel like we must act a certain way to be accepted—whether it's drinking, drugs, vapes, smoking, inappropriate relationships, or social media trends.	Gain Courage Against Peer Pressure. Just like these three men refused to bow, we can refuse to compromise our values.
We face challenges—bullying, family struggles, self-doubt, social media influence	Understand that God is with us in the fire, even when we feel like no one supports us, He will never leave you alone.
Sometimes, life is tough, and we don't always see immediate answers to our prayers.	Stay firm in our faith, trust in God, and He will give us strength to overcome.
Just as God was with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, He is with you today. Whatever we are facing, we don't have to fight alone. Stand firm in our faith, trust in God, and He will give us strength to overcome.



Objective: To help the children understand that true joy comes from Jesus Christ and not from external circumstances.

Thought for the day : "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete." St. John 15:11

Introduction:

Joy

A student wins a sports competition (happiness), but what happens if they lose the next game? Will their happiness remain? Happiness is like a flashlight: It works only when the batteries (good circumstances) are in place. Joy is like the sun: It keeps shining even when clouds (hard times) come.

Jesus Himself promises everlasting joy to those who believe in Him. Joy is an inner feeling. Happiness is an outward expression. Joy endures hardship and trials and connects with meaning and purpose. Joy is deep, lasting, and comes from a relationship with Jesus.

- ↓ What happens when those things are taken away?
- ↓ What are things that try to steal your joy?
- ↓ How can you find joy in Jesus daily?

- **True Joy will not dependent on the situation.** Philippians 4:4 - "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!"
- **True Joy comes from knowing that God is working in us all the time.** James 1:2-3 - "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance."
- **True Joy strengthens us in tough times.** Nehemiah 8:10 - "The joy of the Lord is your strength."
- **True Joy is found in sharing Jesus with others.** Luke 15:7 - "There will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent."

Keep JESUS as your first priority (Proverbs 3:6)

Seek God's guidance in every aspect of your life (Psalms 32:8)

CHRIST CENTERED LIFE

Follow the commandments of HOLY SPIRIT (St. John 14:26)

Have the attitude of CHRIST (Philippians 2:5)

How to Live in the Joy of Jesus?

- Abide in Christ** - (John 15:4-5) The closer we are to Jesus, the more joy we experience
- Pray & Worship** - (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18) Focus on God's blessings rather than problems
- Serve Others** - (Acts 20:35) Joy grows when we love and help others
- Trust God in Hard times** - (Romans 8:28) Even in struggles, God has a plan for our good.

If our joy is permanently rooted in an unchanging person, Jesus Christ, we can have joy that cannot be moved by our circumstances.

In the four short chapters that comprise the book of Philippians, Apostle Paul uses the Greek word for joy or rejoicing sixteen times, even as he writes from a jail cell. Paul knows that true joy is permanently rooted in Jesus- the real, living, reigning savior. This is why he can pen his most joyful letter amidst immense suffering. He knew the truth of the song we sing every Christmas: "Joy to the world, the Lord has come." This means our joy is found only in Jesus, a real person with real flesh and bones. When Jesus was raised to life to sit beside the Father,





he placed his Spirit within us. Psalm 16:11 says, "in your presence there is fullness of joy." With the Spirit residing within us, we have unlimited access to this joy.

The Story of Paul and Silas, the effect of finding true Joy in the Prison (Acts 16:16-40)


Paul and Silas travelled from city to city, spreading the Gospel. One day, in the city of Philippi, they healed a girl who was possessed by an evil spirit. While this was a good thing, the people who were making money from her fortune-telling got angry. They stirred up a crowd against Paul and Silas, and soon, the city officials ordered them to be beaten and thrown into prison.

Imagine this:

They were beaten !!

They were chained !!

They had no idea what would happen next !!



Most people in their situation would be angry or hopeless.

But what did Paul and Silas do?

They Chose to Worship Instead of Worrying.... Because they had the true Joy in Jesus Acts 16:25 says: "Around midnight, Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them.

- Instead of complaining, they prayed.
- Instead of crying out in pain, they sang praises to God.
- Instead of feeling hopeless, they found joy in Jesus.

Their joy wasn't based on their circumstances—
it was BASED ON THEIR FAITH IN JESUS

1. Joy isn't based on circumstances



Many people think joy comes from success, popularity, or having an easy life.

But Paul and Silas show us that even in suffering, we can have joy because Jesus is with us.

No matter what we're going through, Jesus offers a joy that isn't temporary—it's eternal.



2. Worship changes our perspective

When life gets tough, instead of complaining or feeling hopeless, try what Paul and Silas did—**worship, pray, and trust Jesus**. It may not change the situation immediately, but it will change our heart and give us strength.

3. Our joy can impact others

Just like Paul and Silas' joy changed the life of the jailor, when we live with the true joy in Jesus, even in our tough times, people around us will notice and get changed. It could be a friend, a sibling, or even someone who doesn't believe in Jesus yet. Our faith might lead them to ask, "How can you still have joy?" and **open the door for us to share about our Savior Jesus**.


Greetings in the name of Holy Triune God Almighty,

- 3. Jesus is Our Source of Joy**


Through these lessons, children will discover how to trust in God, see His presence in every phase of life, and experience the unwavering joy that comes from knowing Jesus Christ.
